On behalf of your Board of Directors, welcome to 2023 - FINALLY! At times it seemed like 2022 was never going to end, but we made it. Now we can focus on getting our lives back on track and making 2023 a better year.

And your Board has been working to do just that. Wait until you see the lineup of events we have planned for you. Rest assured that we kept some of the old favourites as well as some of the ones we introduced during 'the Covid years'. Then we found some new ones we just know you are going to love!

While on the topic of events, we need to let you know that we have had to make the difficult decision to implement some changes to event attendance. It's not something we wanted to do, but we now have well over 1500 families in our members' database. As you can appreciate, providing free tickets to all of our events for everyone has created quite a financial strain, especially considering there was almost no fundraising due to Covid restrictions for over 2 years.

The changes to come are as follows:

A family's **Active Status** will be extended to 6 years after diagnosis (or until the patient turns 19) from the current 4 years. If a relapse occurs, the 6 year count will start over (or until the patient turns 19). During that time, events will continue to be free to the patient, parents and siblings who live in the house and are under the age of 19. Siblings who live in the house and are 19 and over will be considered as guests and will be required to pay a guest fee if one has been set for a particular event.

Alumni Status will take effect at the end of the 6 year Active Status. At that time, there will be a nominal fee for attendance at events for the patient, parents and siblings who live in the house and are under the age of 19. Siblings who live in the house and are 19 and over will be considered as guests and will be required to pay a guest fee if one has been set for a particular event.

Unless otherwise stated, you cannot invite more guests to an event than you have family members attending. NOTE: Exceptions will be the Bulls and Bikes Rodeo and NHL Alumni Hockey Game.

Our programmer is working on making these changes and we will send out an email as soon as they take effect, which should be very soon.

Thank you for understanding that this is a necessary step to ensure that we can continue to fund paid parking, clinic supports and all of the other services we provide.


