Due to limited funds, the program cannot cover off-therapy appointments or the cost of two passes for any family. One pass per family – no exceptions. The passes are recorded in your child's name, so always give his/her name when picking up your passes.

Important note: The parking Staff cannot issue a pass or reload a card unless a completed and signed Parking Authorization Form is presented. Be sure to get your form from your Social Worker or Interlink Nurse before you leave the ward. Any abuse of the program will result in the immediate disqualification of the offending family.

Event Policy Updates

HACS has been serving our families for over 30 years, providing support and programming to families impacted by childhood cancer. To ensure the sustainability of our services and to continue offer quality events, we have updated our **Event Registration and Attendance Policy** and established an **Event Cost Policy**.

Over the past year, we have encountered a significant challenge: last-minute cancellations and no-shows on event days. These unexpected changes have resulted in financial losses exceeding \$6,000 for our organization.

Both of the policies are included at the end of this newsletter. Please make sure that you read through them carefully.

Thank you for standing with us, for believing in our cause, and for being the driving force behind our efforts.



Event Registration and Attendance Policy

Registration

Families who wish to attend our events are required to register in advance through our family event registration page.

Cancellation of Registration

We understand that circumstances can change, and plans may need to be adjusted. Therefore, we encourage families to notify us promptly if they are no longer able to attend an event they have registered for.

Families are required to inform us of any changes in their attendance status no later than the cut-off date provided prior to the scheduled event. This advance notice helps us optimize event arrangements and consider families on our waiting list.

Benefits of Timely Notification

Timely notifications of changes in attendance enable us to take appropriate actions, which may include reducing admissions and thereby lowering the overall cost of the event.

In cases where there is a waiting list for an event, early notifications allow us to offer tickets to families on the waiting list, ensuring that as many families as possible can participate.

Consequences of Failure to Attend without Notification

Families who fail to attend an event for which they have registered, without providing notification by the cut-off, will have their names recorded as non-attendees and will be issued a strike on their file.

After three instances of failing to attend events without prior notification, a family's record in our member database will be flagged as "Event registrations: revoked." Consequently, such families will no longer be offered the opportunity to attend events organized by us.

Exceptional Circumstances

We understand that there may be valid medical or unforeseen reasons for a family's absence from an event. In such cases, families can request an exception to the attendance policy.

To qualify for an exception, families must provide proper confirmation of the exceptional circumstances causing their absence. This may include medical certificates or other relevant documentation. This documentation can be made by emailing admin@helpachildsmile.com.

Exceptions will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis, and decisions will be made in a fair and compassionate manner.

Conclusion

Our Event Registration and Attendance Policy aims to ensure that our events are well-organized, accommodating, and enjoyable for all participants. By adhering to this policy, families contribute to the success of our events and help us create a positive experience for everyone involved.

Event Cost Policy

Attendance for Active Members

- Attendance at all HACS events is provided free of charge to Active members and their immediate family members.
- -Active status is defined as a period of **6 years from the date of diagnosis**. Members are considered Active during this period and can attend events without any cost.
- -Siblings who are under the age of 19 and parents/guardians of Active members can attend events free of charge as long as the member is under the age of 19.
- -Siblings who are 19 years of age and older are considered guests and may be subject to a nominal fee to attend an event.
- In the event of a member's relapse, the 6-year time frame for complimentary attendance restarts as of the date of the relapse, as long as the member has not reached the age of 19.
- -Active members are permitted to invite guests to select events, with the number of guests and eligible events determined on a per-event basis.

Attendance for Alumni Members

- -Unless otherwise specified, Alumni members and their siblings and/or children, as well as parents, will be subject to a minimal charge for attendance at HACS events.
- -When Alumni members turn 19, parents/guardians and siblings regardless of age are considered guests and may be required to pay the designated guest fee to attend an event.
- -In the event that an Alumni member establishes their own family, their partner and children will take the place of siblings and parents in terms of event attendance.

Rationale and Purpose

The need to introduce nominal charges for Alumni members and their families is driven by the growth and sustainability of our organization. As our membership has expanded over the years, it is essential to ensure our events and programming continue to thrive.

By implementing nominal charges for Alumni members, we can maintain the quality and accessibility of our events while also ensuring the long-term viability of our services.
